



Glove Safety



DO's

- DO use the right glove for proper protection. There can be many hazards for your hands, whether from chemicals, cuts or burns.
- DO provide leadership. If staff do not see managers utilizing proper glove protection, they will be less inclined to observe glove safety procedures.
- DO ensure that you provide your staff with proper training on when to use safety gloves and what types of gloves are required. Make wearing gloves a habit.

DON'T's

- DON'T use a glove that is ripped or torn. Damaged gloves are less able to provide proper hand protection.
- DON'T minimize importance of glove safety. Safety should always be front and center for all aspects of facility maintenance.
